IT DOESN'T ADD UP moved up after the start, was well placed just behind the leader, drafted behind the pacesetter while inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, rallied to make a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and proved best under good handling. TAKING CHARGE shifted out early and bothered MEDIA CONTACT, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the place. SOUTHERN ROCKET tracked the pace, raced three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. STRETCH O'BRIEN was bumped lightly in the hindquarters at the start, easily moved to the lead, set the pace while a bit off the rail, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and weakened then just missed the show. FISH was urged along while just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch and tired. MEDIA CONTACT steadied when TAKING CHARGE came out early, settled at the rear, raced a bit off the rail on the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. MR. FUPEG bumped lightly with the hindquarters of STRETCH O'BRIEN at the start, settled on the outside, went four wide on the turn and faltered.
