MOLLY B WILD lunged at the break, raced within striking distance, bid outside for the drive, loomed a threat but did not have enough late. SWING LADY SWING set the pace until before the final sixteenth and gave way grudgingly. DYNA PENNY settled. ROYAL TURKA was outrun. GARNETTA tired. RIO DE ORO had no speed and was not a threat. THREE YOUNG SONS stalked SWING LADY SWING until upper stretch and stopped.
