WELL SAID within striking distance, rallied three wide for the drive, bid outside the leaders nearing mid stretch, gained the edge late and then held on. RED RAYMOND reserved until nearing the second turn, rallied wide but was too late. CROSSWORD trailed early, made a four wide move around the second turn, bid outside MR. MESO before mid stretch, gained the edge then was no match late. SAINT ANDDAN stalked MR. MESO from early on, took over down the backstretch, got headed nearing the final furlong and then faded late. DA CARDINAL improved position. SIR HALORY was outrun. MR. MESO held the early lead, was displaced by SAINT ANDDAN down the backstretch, came again for the drive and then faltered late. OLD COLONY dropped back. SUPERSTONE forwardly placed for a half, gave way.
