### Footnotes

FIST OF RAGE contested the lead while four to five wide on the first turn, moved clear with five furlongs to run, controlled the tempo while off the rail on the far turn, accelerated further clear when asked near the three-sixteenths pole, drew off into the final furlong and held sway under steady urging. BAUERS GOT HOURS raced four to five wide on the first turn, was unhurried on the outside, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, shifted out and brushed with SAN TURNERO at the top of the stretch, was put a left-handed whip, moved into second approaching the furlong marker and finished well but was too late. ELUSIVE COMMANDER lagged at the rear of the field while off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, shifted out near the three-sixteenths pole and got up for the show. HOLLY JET raced near the rail on the first turn, settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out behind traffic in upper stretch and failed to rally. SAN TURNERO raced three wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, brushed with BAUERS GOT HOURS and also failed to rally. TUCKY raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four wide while under urging on the far turn, loomed a danger into the stretch but came up empty. PIOUS PREACHER was well placed behind the leaders, advanced three wide while urged along on the far turn but also came up empty. CHANGING STORM contested the early pace while towards the inside, dropped back near the five-eighths pole, chased while inside on the far turn and tired. (Rail at 20 Feet)
