WITS END chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed strongly to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. LEGACY OF TRUTH showed early speed then chased BRING THE WOOD, raced three then two wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, dropped back a bit while under a drive in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole but just missed. THE LOUISIANA KID was urged along towards the front, chased four wide on the turn and closed well but missed. SWOROVSKI chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, took the lead at the top of the stretch, inched clear near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken. HUD'S REBELLION was unprepared at the start, broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, saved ground early on the turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and reached his best stride too late. BROCKBERG broke a bit slow, was ridden along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. LIME ME broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, went two then three wide on the turn and also failed to threaten. IDE'S CROWN was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. BRING THE WOOD moved up to take the lead, set the pace, lost the advantage at the top of the stretch and

gave way. NAVY SEAL TEAM SIX was reluctant to load, came away awkwardly, was ridden along towards the back, went four then five wide on the turn and was no factor. ROB HOW was ridden along towards the middle of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. POP DARBONNE broke a bit slow, moved up down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and also came up empty.
