BREACH OF PROMISE veered out into SILENT OATH at the break, was straightened, raced between foes early and then lacked a rally. DON'T SUGAH ME unhurried, was outrun. MY GIDDY AUNT (IRE) showed little. AMIDST STORM raced wide and faded. COZY B. J. showed early speed and then tired. BILOXI PROSPECT forwardly placed off the rail, trailed to lug out midway around the turn and then dropped back.
