**Footnotes**

BET THE POWER was well placed just off the pace, ranged up while four wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, inched clear near the three-sixteenths pole, drew away into the final furlong then was ridden out while racing erratically. RIVER CITY GEM showed early speed, set the early pace, lost the advantage outside the half-mile pole, chased three wide on the turn and earned the place while no match for the winner. SMARTY GRAS was last away, moved up on the inside, took the lead outside the half-mile pole, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole and weakened then missed the place. SAINT WILL was a bit slow into stride, settled on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and failed to rally. STEALTH HERO settled off the early pace then came under urging, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. AVOID settled near the back, was urged along while off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. TRUE SWITHER veered out at the start, settled on the outside, went five wide on the turn and faded.
