### Footnotes

SOUTHERN REGION showed good speed, accelerated to a clear lead, dictated terms through the turn, responded well when put to the whip in upper stretch and drew off under strong urging. TI TOWNSHIP was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and just earned the place. EVACUATION ROUTE bumped with a rival at the start then came in, was ridden along towards the rear, raced three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and just missed the place. BAUERS GOT HOURS broke in the air then dropped back, raced at the rear of the field while off the inside, angled out while gaining near the sixteenth-pole and improved position. ROYAL AGO was bumped soundly at the start, raced well back in the field while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and gained ground in the stretch drive but failed to menace. ST. RAPHAEL (IRE) bumped with a rival at the start then was carried in, was guided along towards the front of the field, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. EURO SILVER JET bumped with a rival at the start, steadied in the early going then was ridden along, raced three wide on the turn and also failed to rally. CLASSY DEELITES chased the pace on the outside, drifted out in upper stretch and weakened. KRISTYS MARQ showed good speed on the inside, was taken back near the half-mile pole, lost position nearing the turn and faded. (Rail at 20 Feet)
