RAHY'S SECRET devoid speed down the backstretch, raced inside around the turn, eased out for the drive, was switched out inside the final sixteenth and finished determinedly to get up in time. CASHEL CASTLE out sprinted early, loomed three wide for the drive, gained the lead late and then could not hold on. TRICKY STORM sprinted clear to the rail down the backstretch, remained clear for the drive, responded when collared and then faltered late. DASH FOR DAYLIGHT moved to the rail early, continued inside and had no rally. RED LIGHTNING devoid speed, improved position wide. TWO PUNCH SONNY was never dangerous. BONAPAW showed early speed, moved outside before the turn then gave way nearing mid stretch.
