MORGAN THE MIGHTY brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, made a bid while two to three wide on the turn, battled with SHANGHAI JIM into the final furlong then drew clear under steady urging. SHANGHAI JIM was fractious in the gate, bumped with a rival at the start, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three to four wide on the turn, floated five wide into the stretch, battled into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. I KNOW YOU SEE IT bumped with a rival at the start then was taken up, moved up into the middle of the field, raced under steady restraint from the five-eighths pole to the three-eighths pole, went two to three wide on the turn, drifted in near the furlong marker and lacked the

needed response while able to get the show. ELI IS A GIANT was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and came up empty. T SITA was bumped on both sides at the start then taken up, raced well back in the field, went five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and improved position. BEACH HAT bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced five wide on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SOUTHERN FLING bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along near the back, went five wide on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and also failed to threaten. ZUPPARDO'S ALLUSION was reluctant to load, dropped back while urged along, went three then two wide on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. JERMEY'S FINEST bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. COHEN'S BANDITO set the pace, lost the lead passing the three-eighths pole, chased into the stretch and tired. WEATHER WARRIOR chased the pace on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn, floated seven wide into the stretch and capitulated. ROCKY CASCADE was bumped on both sides at the start, raced near the back, went four then three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail at the top of the stretch and was no factor. SELINA'S STORM was urged along in the front half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and faded. ISAIAH'S WALK brushed with a rival at the start and was taken up a bit, was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and faltered.
