Final closing on November 7, 2008 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box; starters to pay an additional \$400. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner; \$20,000 to second; \$11,000 to third; \$6,000 to fourth; \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. (Winners Preferred) NOTE: Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. BREAK UP unhurried early, moved in a bit going to the turn, advanced nearing the drive, was eased out inside the final furlong and got up late. COCKTAIL CLARENCE forwardly placed outside early, moved in nearing the turn, came three wide around the turn, bid outside the leaders approaching mid stretch, drifted out and then in late while saving second. FOREIGN PRODUCTION chased NOT GROUNDED to before the drive, loomed turning for home, gained the edge, then faltered late. GASTON off last, moved up before the turn, awaited room entering the turn, split foes before the drive, rallied gamely but was in tight late. TELLING JOHN SCOTT bobbled at the break, raced well back to the drive, then showed late interest while widest. LEESTOWN GIFT eased to the inside early, continued along the rail around the turn, moved out after entering the drive, then could make little impact. NOT GROUNDED cleared to the inside early, responded when collared a quarter out, then faltered once headed in mid stretch. TWO NICKEL BUD raced inside too no avail. BURNING THE RULES bothered at the break, was not a threat. GREEN CASCADE showed little. SILENT PIPE veered out into BURNING THE RULES leaving the gate, was straightened, then raced wide. SEA THE SOLDIER showed early foot, then retreated.
