Footnotes

MY FRIEND JIMMY broke a bit slow, was taken under a strong hold while eager towards the rear, remained towards the back while under restraint, moved closer on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, shifted four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and drew away under steady urging. BACARDI CAT RUN was taken under a tight hold, raced three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled with the winner into the final furlong and proved no match while clear for the place. ANEXECUTIVEOPENING raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened while able to hold the show. MEH YEAH was taken in hand before the first turn, saved ground on that bend, moved up outside the half-mile pole, advanced closer passing that marker, chased inside on the far turn and tired. BANG BANG BERTI went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused while three wide on the far turn, moved out in the final furlong and failed to rally. GOOFY GOVERNOR was bumped hard by EDDIE JUNIOR at the start, bumped lightly with that rival in the early going, went four wide on the first turn, moved up outside the half-mile pole, raced three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. SPENDARIDGE was well placed just off the pace, dropped back near the half-mile pole, saved ground while under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. EDDIE JUNIOR veered in at the start and bumped hard with GOOFY GOVERNOR, bumped lightly with that rival while very eager early, moved up into the first turn, raced three to four wide on that bend, tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn and capitulated. ST CHARLES SHOBIZ broke last then was taken up when EDDIE JUNIOR veered in, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, came under the whip while off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. (Rail at 25 Feet)
