SATURDAYATBERNIES broke in at the start but was away alertly, contested the pace on the outside, moved clear leaving the backstretch, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held determinedly under strong urging. KIPTASTIC came in at the start and bumped TAKE IT LIKE A MAN, recovered well and disputed the pace on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased inside on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the place. BOSS MAN ROCKET was well placed behind the leading duo, went three wide on the turn, was asked after turning into the stretch, made a bid near the furlong marker but was outfinished while well clear for the show. FREE WORLD was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. GUESS MY NAME was whacked in the head by the left stall door at the start, lacked early speed while urged along, went three wide on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. SHORT STORY LONG stumbled at the start, settled at the rear, raced inside while under some urging on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and was no factor. I'M IN CAT was bumped hard at the start, raced on the inside while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. TAKE IT LIKE A MAN broke awkwardly then was bumped hard at the break, made solid contact with rivals on both sides, raced towards the rear and never reached contention. CORPORATE INTRIGUE was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and also failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
