### Footnotes

ROYAL RONNIE dueled on the inside, brushed with HUDSON'S CREED near the quarter-pole, inched clear outside the furlong marker and held well under strong urging. DURANGO TANGO brushed with a rival at the start, chased the dueling leaders on the outside then three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, pursued the winner in a long drive and was second best. HUDSON'S CREED brushed with a rival after the start, dueled on the outside, brushed with ROYAL RONNIE near the quarter-pole, vied past the three-sixteenths pole and tired while clear for the show. SCOTT'S MELODY broke a bit slow then was taken up and dropped back, raced well behind the field while off the inside and reached his best stride too late. TRUKARMA brushed with rivals at the start, chased the pace on the inside of DURANGO TANGO, raced towards the rail on the turn and weakened. FATTY LANGBEIN was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
