MADE UP brushed with a rival at the start, was unhurried towards the rear while off the inside, went three then four wide on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, closed fast on the outside, drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and surged past MY NOBLE late under good handling. MY NOBLE followed the solo leader from second, chased that rival on the far turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. LUBAVA went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced towards the inside on the far turn, loomed just behind the leader coming to the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. ANELINA went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SILVER FEELING was squeezed at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. INERTIA lingered towards the rear of the field, was ridden along on the far turn and also failed to threaten. COCOA COUTURE settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and was no factor. BONAY'S ARCH broke out at the start then was hustled, set the clear pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired. MAG veered out at the start, went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came up empty while four wide on the far turn and retreated.
