Footnotes

STREET SERENADE was asked from the start, raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, was asked at the top of the stretch, inched clear under the whip outside the furlong marker and held well under strong urging. SCAT ABOUT settled at the rear, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went two then three wide on the far turn, came under the whip at the quarter-pole, chased the winner into the final furlong and finished willingly while second best. BLUFFALATTA broke alertly and quickly took the lead, was taken under a strong hold while off the rail on the first turn, disputed the pace, vied near the inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, dropped back under the whip in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. THWART dropped to the inside entering the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while continuing to save ground on the far turn and failed to rally. FOUR JOES went four wide on the first turn, settled in third position, came under urging with a half-mile to run, was ridden along while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. VERY LUCKY went five wide on the first turn, was urged some while outside on the backstretch, dropped back while four then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten.
