OVER IT was urged along while off the pace, bumped with SLEW OF HALOS leaving the backstretch, raced a bit off the rail on the turn, was asked for his best near the three-sixteenths pole, moved to the inside coming to the furlong marker, rallied along the rail and closed well to get up at the wire. PALMER TOUR brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn, gained ground on the outside, made a bid near sixteenth-pole then led late but was denied at the wire. RILEY'S VOO DOO was hard ridden while towards the front, raced four wide on the turn, gained ground into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole but just missed. RACING CAJUN was hustled to the lead, set the clear pace, raced inside on the turn, extended the advantage in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but tired and was overtaken. SLEW OF HALOS brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, bumped with OVER IT leaving the backstretch, went two to three wide on the turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. AMBROSE THE GREAT bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, went three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and improved position without threatening. BIG LEVI chased the pace on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and tired. DIXIE LULLABY was ridden along while well off the pace and never reached contention. KING CHARGER raced well back in the field and showed little. DEWBERRY was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, bumped hard with THE ASHMAN inside the quarter-pole and was nearly knocked down, moved out before the furlong marker and also failed to threaten. DA WHO DAT PRINCE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three to four wide on the turn and was no factor. EASY DANCER broke about six to seven lengths behind the field, raced at the rear and also was no factor. CAYENNE NATIVE was a bit washy, chased the pace through the turn and weakened. THE ASHMAN bumped lightly with rivals at the start, chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, bumped hard with DEWBERRY inside the quarter-pole and gave way.
