Footnotes

HAWAAKOM was rated while inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped back some outside the half-mile pole, moved out on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied quickly on the outside, closed well to get the lead coming to the eighth-pole, drifted in shortly thereafter, was straightened by the rider and moved clear under a strong drive. BEMATA went five then four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, made a bid between rivals on the far turn, poked a head on front, responded well when put to a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead to the winner near the furlong marker, fought on well into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while clear for the place. PERFECT TITLE was eased back into the first turn then settled on the inside, came under urging while off the rail on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved to the outside and got up for the show. DOC ALMON went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, bumped with GET IN LINE near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed kick. HAPPYISOUTBACK raced three wide early on the first turn then shifted five wide, settled on the outside, moved up with five furlongs to run, made a bid while three to four wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. GET IN LINE went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, advanced into a good striking position, came five wide into the stretch, bumped with DOC ALMON near the three-sixteenths pole and tired. RAP D'ORO went four then three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, shifted five wide outside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. QUELCH was reserved towards the rear, bided his time on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and also failed to rally. MONEY CANNON raced four then three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, came under urging on the far turn, dropped out outside the quarter-pole and gave way. KEG PARTY contested the pace, dropped back near the five-eighths pole, came under urging on the far turn and capitulated.
