BLESSED MOON was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and held well under strong urging then was flagged with the whip late. PREMO'S STAR was in tight off heels nearing the first turn then reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. SYLVIA TWICE went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, raced three then two wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the winner in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick then missed the place. SARAH'S KITTEN went three to four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, chased four then three wide on the far turn and weakened. INDIAN TREATY was well placed on the inside, saved ground on both turns and came up empty. FOREVER JENNY raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. RIKKI DEE was taken in hand while in a bit tight between rivals nearing the first turn, raced two then three wide on that turn, settled on the backstretch, was urged along on the far turn and failed to respond.
