SOD GODDESS dueled for the lead, moved clear leaving the backstretch, was challenged again passing the five-sixteenths pole, edged clear outside the furlong marker and proved much the best under strong urging. HALF THEIRS chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, lost touch with the winner outside the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. WILDLEE FUNNY was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and safely secured the show. DOUBLEDEALINGDIVA dropped in while off the pace, saved ground early on the turn, came off the rail approaching the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. TIGRESS QUEEN raced towards the front of the field, was taken in hand while behind rivals leaving the backstretch, went two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. DARLIN DARLENE was ridden along near the back, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. EUGENE'SEXPRESS was hustled from the start, dueled on the outside, dropped back a bit leaving the backstretch, chased early on the turn, made a bid again near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. ALWAYS IN TROUBLE chased the early pace on the inside, was taken in hand while behind rivals passing the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and

came up empty. OPENLY CRITICAL was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond. I'M IN TO SCORE was ridden along towards the back, raced three to four wide on the turn, moved to five wide briefly outside the quarter-pole, dropped back in a bit shortly thereafter and also failed to respond. LEGANDERY RAIN was ridden along while off the pace, raced five to six wide on the turn and faltered. SUMMER TIME RULES lacked early speed, drifted out near the half-mile pole, raced five wide on the turn, floated six wide into the stretch and also faltered.
