Footnotes

SMITTEN saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, remained in hand while off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide then was asked coming to the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. BLUE VIOLET went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, made a bid near the quarter-pole, chased the winner into the final furlong and finished willingly for the place. CORA MESA charged the front of the gate just prior to the start, hit the gate then broke a bit slow, lagged at the rear, moved closer on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch and was best of the rest. SANCTISSIMA brushed with a rival at the start, went to the front, set the clear pace while in hand, was given some free rein on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. TIPSY AT MIDNIGHT brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid midway through the far turn, battled under a drive in upper stretch and tired. TIZEXX went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and faltered. FAIRNESS came in at the start, was rated in third position, came up empty while inside on the far turn and stopped.
