TWO SOUTH allowed to settle, rallied inside approaching the drive, moved out to make contact with OUTER CIRCLE, closed gamely and was up in the final strides. AS GREAT AS SHE IS clear early, was well handled on the lead and just failed to last. OUTER CIRCLE reserved early, rallied four wide approaching the drive, bumped with TWO SOUTH nearing midstretch and failed to sustain his bid. JUNE IN GREEN BAY allowed to settle, brushed rail far turn, angled out and was late. GIVEN TERMS lacked a serious rally. PASS THE SILVER saved ground, then improved position. WINTER RUN failed to menace. EARTHY BROAD raced wide and failed to menace. LAHAINA LASS close up, bid around the final turn and weakened. AVIDE trailed early and showed little. INSEARCHOFGOLD tired from her early efforts. TOMISUE'S DANCER dropped back and was not abused. A stewards inquiry into the running of the eighth race deemed no changes necessary
