MR. SHORTY broke very alertly and quickly took control, set the pace under moderate pressure, dueled inside on the turn, battled under vigorous left hand urging in upper stretch, was switched to a right-handed whip and inched clear into the final furlong then held sway under steady urging. WINKATDAWAT was bumped at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, vied three to four wide on the turn, drew even with the leaders in upper stretch, battled determinedly on the outside and missed. J. BURLE moved out near the five-eighths pole, was ridden along while well off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, came under strong right hand urging and finished willingly for the show. BRAXTON COUNTY broke out and bumped WINKATDAWAT, chased then pressed the leader, dueled while two to three wide on the turn, battled between rivals in upper stretch and tired. SUMKINDAHOUSBURNER settled off the pace, raced inside on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally.
