Footnotes

SOME KINDA TROUBLE settled on the outside, advanced two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead outside the furlong marker and edged clear under steady urging. INVISIBLE FORCE bumped with a rival at the start, settled towards the rear of the field, came under urging with a half-mile to run, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. ALVIN AND DAVID bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, advanced under urging on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and also finished willingly. IRON VOW was reluctant to load, broke outward at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the dueling leaders from third, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, inched clear at the top of the stretch, lost the lead coming to the furlong marker and weakened. TIME TO REIGN dueled on the inside, battled into the stretch and tired. MISTER LUKE bumped with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field, went two then three wide on the far turn and was no factor. CARBON BLUE brushed with MISTER LUKE after the start then was pulled off the heels of that rival, raced three wide on both turns and never reached contention. NUMINOUS was hustled from the start, dueled on the outside, vied into the stretch and stopped.
