FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$400 to enter and \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth; 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since October 17, 2011 allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since then allowed 4 lbs. \$25,000 on the turf since September 17, 2011 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings on the turf in 2010-2011. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees.. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Saturday, December 3, 2011, with 23 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.).

Footnotes

CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE dueled on the outside of GREAT MILLS, drifted out while edging clear in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth and held under steady urging. COUNTRY DAY bumped soundly with the hindquarters of UNO DUCKSY at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, drifted out while under a drive in upper stretch and finished well but failed to reach the winner. SOUTHERN STYLE was ridden along at the rear, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished with good energy for the show. UNO DUCKSY was bumped hard in the hindquarters at the start, raced off the pace while ridden along and failed to rally. GREAT MILLS brushed with a rival after the start, dueled with the winner, vied inside on the turn and tired. CRYSTAL MOMENT bumped lightly with rivals at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and weakened. STRIKE IMPACT was ridden along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. (Rail at 0 Feet)
