**Footnotes**

DIXON LANE raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved well back in the field, went three then four wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied well out in the course, closed strongly to get the lead near the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. NEWSDAD was off slow, lagged near the back of the field, swung seven wide into the stretch and finished well to get the place. SORGHO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, circled the field while six wide on the far turn, took the lead at the top of the stretch, drifted in a bit near the furlong marker, lost the lead and weakened while able to get the show. GRIND went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, rallied five wide on the far turn, steadied while in tight at the top of the stretch, quickly regained momentum, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished. NOLANGRANT'SKITTEN was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was blocked behind a wall of horses on the turn, continued blocked in upper stretch, moved to the outside and finished willingly in a tough trip. OLD BUSHMILL brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. MR. UNCLE NED broke inward and brushed with a rival, was rated under a very tight hold, continued under stout restraint while blocked on the far turn, continued blocked in upper stretch, came between rivals near the furlong marker and also failed to rally. MR. POPPS raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the

field, was blocked behind traffic on the far turn, came between rivals in upper stretch and failed to respond. SURF CAST raced four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and gave way. FRANKIE DAPPER came in and brushed with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn, was in tight at the top of the stretch and came up empty. JACK'S SOUL broke inward at the start, set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside on the far turn and tired. PAPAGAYO tracked the pace, vied between rivals on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 10 Feet)
