FOREST UPROAR bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, moved closer while four wide on the far turn, rallied into the stretch, closed well to get the lead near the furlong marker and edged clear under good handling. GOING TO THE SUN tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while just able to get the place. IN THE SLIPS raced two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. HIGH QUALITY bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, moved up leaving the backstretch, prompted the leader on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and was also outfinished then missed the minor awards. EPIPHANYFORTIFFANY set the pace while well rated, was set down at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened then was denied the minor awards. CAMINADORA lingered well back in the field, raced inside on the far turn, moved out some in upper stretch, came between rivals inside the furlong marker, was gaining ground late then lacked room near the wire and missed the minor awards. NOW AND FOREVER bumped with rivals at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, went two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. DANCIN PERFECT settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. P. S. I LOVE YOU bumped with rivals at the start, raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. DARK STARLET bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MAESTRO MISS settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and failed to respond. MUFFIN bumped with a rival at the start, lagged well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. (Rail at 10 Feet)
