COUNTRY FLAVOR raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, waited while off the rail on the far turn, came under urging at the top of the stretch, was guided out near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. Z HUMOR raced four wide on the first turn, prompted the leader on the outside while under a tight hold, drew even while three wide on the far turn, gained a short lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed drive in upper stretch, shook off RECAPTURETHEGLORY near the sixteenth-pole but was denied late. DUBIOUS MISS settled on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, waited while saving ground on the far turn, was roused at the top of the stretch, moved out a bit, lacked room coming to the furlong marker, dropped to the inside and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. RECAPTURETHEGLORY settled in third, moved closer while four wide and urged along on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened. ATONED was unhurried at the back of the field, raced two then three wide on the far turn, shifted out once straightened for the drive and failed to rally. SMARTEN DESTINY was well rated while off the rail, lost the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. MAD FLATTER raced three then four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went five wide on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole and came up empty.
