STAKES Letellier Memorial S. - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES. Free nomination by Saturday, December 10th, 2011. \$300 to enter and \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 which includes \$10,000 for LA Breds from ALBSS of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight :122lbs, Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2lbs, \$25,000 allowed 4lbs, \$18,000 allowed 6lbs (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. This stake will be limited to 14 starters with Also Eligibles. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest lifetime earnings. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, December 10, 2011, with 11 nominations.

GOOD DEED showed good speed, dictated terms while on the inside, responded well when asked in upper stretch and proved much the best under steady urging. SWIFT ARTIST broke out at the start, showed early speed then dropped back while urged along, chased three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and was second best. OUR ELEANOR was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally while able to get the show. COLOR CODE chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and tired. LOST FRIEND was ridden along while well behind the field, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten.
