MT. ST. MICHEL allowed to settle, rallied from between rivals in upper stretch, angled out eight wide, gained the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. COME ON GOLDIE off last, swung out ten wide for the drive and closed late. LUCKY BAYOU never far back, rallied six wide in the lane and lacked the needed kick. PRINCESS DARE close up while out sprinted, ranged up three wide a quarter out, gained the lead and faltered late. PRINCESS BELEK raced four wide while outrun, lacked a rally nine wide. BOLD LOUISA out sprinted early, lacked a rally between rivals. SILK LINE LADY saved ground much of the trip and could make little impact. STOKEM saved ground while unhurried, remained inside and had no rally. COLORMEGREEN hard pressed while holding the lead and faltered once reaching midstretch. CHAD'S PROSPECT forced the pace and stopped.
