Footnotes

BIORRA brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the leader on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, disposed of RECOUNTED inside the furlong marker and edged clear under steady urging. RECOUNTED came away in good order, sped clear and set the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong then was outfinished while clear for the place. JETABUG brushed with a rival at the start, settled in third, bided her time while off the rail on the turn, was roused coming to the quarter-pole, angled out inside that pole, was put to the whip and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. GOLDILOX broke about three lengths slow, dropped in then moved up on the inside, saved ground while just behind the leaders on the turn but had nothing left for the drive. MASAKO settled well off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. DA BLAZ N BELLS settled at the back of the field, came under urging while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond.
