WAJIR ON ME settled off the pace, bided her time while inside on the far turn, moved out and was roused in upper stretch, rallied between rivals to make a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled gamely in the final furlong and prevailed under good handling. ATTEMPTED HUMOR settled nicely while towards the front, was urged a bit while off the rail on the far turn, came under stronger urging at the top of the stretch, made a bid between rivals passing the eighth-pole, battled determinedly in the final furlong but was outfinished while just able to get the place. STRIKING HIGHT settled on the inside, moved off the rail on the far turn, shifted five wide into the stretch, made a bid between rivals entering the final furlong and was also outfinished then just missed the place. CAJUN PRIZE went three then two wide on the first turn, was rated while tracking the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out at the top of the stretch, made a bid entering the final furlong and again was outfinished. BOND STREET broke a bit awkwardly, was reserved at the back of the field, remained at the back through the far turn, was roused in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker

and finished willingly. ONE MORE KING went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went two then three wide on the far turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole, came six wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. SPEIGHTSTOWN SON contested the pace, moved clear when asked on the far turn, battled into the final furlong then weakened. THEATRICAL'S HALO raced four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. ORO TRIBUTO raced three wide on the first turn, lagged at the back of the field, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. RARE FLYER was taken in hand early, raced four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under a ride while three to four wide on the turn, raced in good attacking range into upper stretch then dropped out. LUDMIG raced four then three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn and gave way. (Rail at 10 Feet)
