POLITICAL AGENDA went four wide on the first turn, was rated in third position while on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, took the lead after turning into the stretch, was asked outside the eighth-pole, battled with KELLY'SPREMONITION in the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. KELLY'SPREMONITION settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, drafted behind the pacesetter on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch, battled determinedly in the final furlong and missed. SUN BEAR went to the front, raced off the rail on the first turn, set the clear pace while in hand, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and was outfinished but finished willingly to just get the show. CABERNEIGH was off about two to three lengths slow, went four then three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, advanced into a good striking position but lacked the needed kick and just missed the show.

WHEEMAWAY settled while off the inside, was roused on the far turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. MINI MINE MO went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. GOOD PROSPECT raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn and tired. MEEZAAN (IRE) broke about two lengths slow, was very rank while under heavy restraint early, settled a bit while inside on the first turn, lingered towards the back while along the rail, saved ground on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond. TAKING CHARGE was taken wide on the first turn and pulled up then walked off. Following a stewards' inquiry, WAR HOOT was declared a non-starter for being left behind the gate at the start and scratched. (Rail at 10 Feet)
