TIMBER LEGEND devoid speed, rallied outside around the second turn, closed determinedly and prevailed. THE LOOPER back early, eased to the inside while reserved, moved out nearing the drive, closed gamely but was out finished. FAIR WINDS saved ground early, eased out for the drive, then closed late to finish on equal terms with TOMO for the show. TOMO close up from early on, ranged up outside RAISE A MIESQUE turning for home, gained the lead between calls, weakened late and lasted to finish on equal terms with FAIR WINDS for the show. BLUE CHAMPAGNE unhurried, loomed between foes in the lane but did not have enough late. FOURCHON allowed to settle, bid outside nearing the drive and then flattened out. WEST BY DIXIE far back until the drive, showed late interest. RAISE A MIESQUE close up, took over outside RA DER DEAN completing a half, got headed and faltered inside the final furlong. ANOTHER SHOW saved ground to no avail. LADY KREW forwardly placed, ranged up before the drive and then stopped. PIKECITY BAILEYS showed speed along the inside and dropped back once turning for home. RA DER DEAN sprinted clear early, was displaced midway down the backstretch,

then stopped in upper stretch.
