Footnotes

DEADLY CATCH was rated just off the pace under a snug hold, remained on hold while off the rail on the turn, moved closer in upper stretch with very slight movement of the hands of the rider, cruised to the lead inside the furlong marker and drew off without being asked to win handily. LA PIANO MAN was hustled from the start, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, gained the lead at the top of the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final furlong but was easily collared then proved no match for the winner but saved the place. LITTLE DOLLAR bumped with a rival at the start, raced under restraint near the back of the field, was carried five wide leaving the backstretch, advanced five wide on the turn, loomed a threat into the stretch, was put to a strong right-handed whip and weakened then just missed the place. METEOR ATTACK was reluctant to load, bumped with LITTLE DOLLAR at the start, was urged some at the back of the field, lugged out leaving the backstretch, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. EXPECT A RED BIRD was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. FLYIN FAGER was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and faded. MIGHTY RIGHT smashed through the front of the gate prior to the start and was washy, was deemed fit to run by the state veterinarian, contested the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and stopped.
