Footnotes

SOLAR NIGHT brushed with a rival just after the start, moved up under his own power, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, was set down after straightening for the drive, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and drew clear under strong urging. KATILLAC CHARM was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and safely secured the place. I'M IN A HURRY showed good speed, set the pace under some pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, dropped closer to the inside at the top of the stretch, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole while under a drive and tired while clear for the show. GO LIL TIGER showed early speed, pressed the pace, chased three wide on the turn and tired. SEQUOYAH WELLS chased the pace, lugged out near the half-mile pole, jostled with SHOCKMAN then dropped back, lugged out while trying to be kept in on the turn, was taken up some in the process, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. SHOCKMAN raced towards the rear while on the outside, jostled with SEQUOYAH WELLS near the half-mile pole, went four then five wide on the turn and failed to respond. TWO THIRD BIRD dropped well behind while ridden along and was distanced.
