Footnotes

COOL STREET went four then three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, was asked outside the three-sixteenths pole, began to drift out when put to a left-handed whip approaching the furlong marker, continued to drift out while battling with FLASHY SUNRISE, brushed with that rival near the sixteenth-pole, was straightened by the rider using the left rein and gamely prevailed under continued left hand urging. FLASHY SUNRISE raced five wide into the first turn then dropped to three wide, was reserved off the pace, moved closer leaving the backstretch, came under urging while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, battled with COOL STREET while being carried out, brushed with that rival near the sixteenth-pole and just missed. EMPIRE TAKER was rated while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch and proved no match for the top two while able to get the show. MAJESTIC LITE contested the pace on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. MADRIS raced three then two wide on the first turn, disputed the pace on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, vied between horses into the stretch and tired. LAUGH IT OFF went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and faded. VPERYOD SERYOGA raced two to three wide on both turns and showed little. NEW RULER broke a bit slow, dropped well behind and was outrun. Following a stewards' review of the stretch run, no change was made to the order of finish.
