ROLFS ROSSINI was well rated while setting the pace, came under the whip in upper stretch, inherited a sizeable advantage when his closer pursuer broke down at the furlong marker and proved much the best under strong urging. MR. ANDREW settled on the inside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, steadied off heels entering the far turn, moved off the rail shortly thereafter, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and safely secured the place. COUPEE went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, was asked early on the far turn, chased three to four wide into the stretch and tired while best of the rest. MY FRIEND TAG settled on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. CHRISAGOGO was rated while off the pace, came under a strong ride on the far turn and capitulated. TRAVELING STONE was reserved while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole and was no factor. HERE COMES JUNIOR was last away, lagged at the rear and showed little. IDE BE DA GENERAL went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, went wrong at the furlong marker and was pulled up then vanned off.
