GOOD HUMOR GAL close up, ranged up three wide approaching the drive, surged clear before mid stretch and held on. SONG TRACK moved to the rail early, advanced between foes down the backstretch, eased back to the rail entering the second turn, continued inside around the turn, eased out after turning for home, closed willingly but was too late. EXPLICITLY reserved early, advanced outside SONG TRACK around the second turn and then lacked the needed finish. TEA IS SERVED set the pace until nearing the drive and faltered once headed. WOOD NOT stalked TEA IS SERVED until turning for home and tired. HUMOROUS MISS wide early, faded. BEAU HAPPY trailed until the drive and then improved position. STRIKING AUDREY was never dangerous. LEFTY'S LADY saved ground and then faded. PAD THE WALLET showed little. WILD TEARS outrun early, dropped back.
