Footnotes

SWIFTWATER ROGUE bobbled ever so slightly just after the start, went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was asked when joined on the inside by GOINGOINGONE at the quarter-pole, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under steady urging. CRISTOVIA contested the early pace on the outside while under a snug hold, lost the lead when EL WOODROW moved up outside the half-mile pole, moved to the outside of that rival, made a bid passing the seven-sixteenths pole, inched clear at the top of the stretch, was put to the whip near the three-sixteenths pole, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. GOINGOINGONE was reserved on the inside, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back a bit leaving the backstretch, was urged along on the far turn, came off the rail while cutting into the lead at the quarter-pole, chased under the whip in upper stretch and weakened while able to secure the show. STRAIGHT UP BILL lagged near the back while on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, lugged inward in upper stretch and failed to rally. JOSEPH BLACK broke a bit slow, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved at the back, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths while under stout restraint, was given some free rein midway through the far turn, hesitated at the top of the stretch, came under the whip shortly thereafter and failed to threaten. EL WOODROW shifted three wide late on the first bend, moved up on the outside, took the lead outside the five-eighths pole, vied inside on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. FEATURE WINNER went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was hard ridden while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond. ROYAL FRIEND contested the early pace while under a hold, was taken back leaving the first turn then rated off the pace, came up empty on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 10 Feet)
