Footnotes

MISS OOPS tracked the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths pole, gained the lead in upper stretch and just held under strong urging. ACACIAN SPICE showed good speed, contested the pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and just missed. QUITE EXPLOSIVE was last away then taken in hand, moved up outside the half-mile pole to dispute the pace while still in hand, vied two to three wide on the turn, was asked after straightening for the drive, battled between rivals into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the show. TELESCOPIC was well placed just off the pace, lugged out a bit while guided around the turn with left rein pressure, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly but missed the show. BELL OF BUDDHA bumped lightly with SECRET HEIRESS after the start, settled on the outside while under some urging, raced five wide early on the turn, dropped in near the three-eighths pole and failed to threaten. SECRET HEIRESS bumped lightly with BELL OF BUDDHA after the start, was rated off the pace, came under urging while four then five wide on the turn and had nothing left.
