Footnotes

MUGHAADIR settled towards the rear while off the inside, was roused on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, angled out while gaining, closed fast to get the lead near the furlong marker then drew away under strong handling. DORSETT went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pacesetter on the outside, raced three wide early on the far turn, was carried five wide midway through that bend, made a bid between rivals passing the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, battled under a drive, drifted out some near the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. HY DANGER bumped with a rival at the start and was last away, went two to three wide early on the first turn then moved to four wide, settled on the outside, went four wide early on the far turn, moved to six wide midway through that bend, continued six wide into the stretch and got up for the show. CALL ME WEST saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out some under a drive in upper stretch and improved position. TAPSION saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while inside on the far turn, took an awkward stride outside the quarter-pole, moved out under the whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. QUITTIN TIME bumped with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced five wide early on the far turn, was carried seven wide midway through that bend, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. GUNDERSON set the pace while off the inside, lugged out to be four wide midway through the far turn, moved to three wide near the five-sixteenths, dropped out leaving the bend and gave way. TIZ THE KID went two to three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was roused on the far turn, made a bid between rivals passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled into upper stretch then weakened. MAJESTIC STRATEGY was bumped on both sides at the start, saved ground on the first turn, was rated off the pace, came under urging near the three-eighths pole, moved up to make a rail bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty in upper stretch and faded.

COUNTERBLOW went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, raced four wide early on the far turn, was carried six wide midway through that bend then taken up, dropped to five wide while falling back and stopped. RED WINGS stumbled entering the first turn, was taken wide and eased but walked off. (Rail at 10 Feet)
