SILVER BREEZE settled off the rail early, advanced around the turn, angled out in upper stretch, rallied and proved clearly best. ANGELS' SHARE raced back to before the drive, angled out in the lane and was along for second. SHE COULD BE GOOD vied for the lead to mid stretch and then faltered late. EVERYTHING'S ROSIE vied for the lead between foes early, continued outside SHE COULD BE GOOD while holding the edge to inside the furlong grounds and then gave way. D'ORO DOLL was outrun. TRISHA'S SILVER reserved off the rail, moved around CHEROKEE SHEIK nearing the drive and was no real threat. CHEROKEE SHEIK prompted the leaders three wide to the turn, was pulled up nearing the drive and then was vanned off.
