Footnotes

GRAN ESTRENO (ARG) raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, waited patiently while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied under left-hand urging, closed well to make a bid near the furlong marker, inched clear into the final sixteenth and held under steady handling. SOUTHERN ANTHEM raced three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear of the field, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, was roused on the far outside, rallied into the final furlong and closed well but missed. READY SET moved out in the early going, raced three to four wide on the first turn, prompted the leader while well out in the course, vied three to four wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong then was outfinished while clear for the show. CABERNEIGH was reserved off the pace, moved up with a half-mile to run, engaged the leader leaving the backstretch, vied two to three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. CROSS VILLAGE was taken back at the start then reserved towards the rear, moved closer with a half-mile to run, held a good striking position while behind the leaders on the far turn, was roused in upper stretch and came up empty. DR LARGE set the pace while into the bit and under restraint, vied inside on the far turn, lacked the needed response when set down at the top of the stretch and gave way. (Rail at 20 Feet)
