Footnotes

ORDINARY TIME dropped to the inside on the first turn, was reserved near the rail, moved closer while under some urging on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved out behind traffic near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to win going away. GUT CHECK was rated just off the pace, moved out on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied to a short lead passing the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while able to get the place. MATTGETSNORESPECT set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled determinedly into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while able to secure the show. PATRYKUS raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly. SKYMAX raced four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a mild bid near the quarter-pole then weakened. STORM OSIDY was well placed on the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. SOUTH RIDGE was given one crack of the whip after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. DAKOTA COMET leaned out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, raced off the rail on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. MIRACLE CREEK lagged well back in the field, moved out early on the backstretch, shifted five wide midway through the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and also failed to threaten. NO LIP was caught five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. MY DADDY HEIR was a bit rank while three wide on the first turn then reserved well off the pace, dropped back while four wide on the far turn and faltered.
