DEPARTING was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, dropped back some while in a bit tight near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, gained the lead entering the final furlong and edged clear under strong urging. GROUND TRANSPORT set the clear pace, took a slightly awkward stride inside the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for his best in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. STOURBRIDGE LION was urged along while off the pace, bumped with FULL HEART while off the rail midway through the turn and was best of the rest. D Y N FOR A STAR chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and tired. VALDINA SAINT was urged along on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and weakened. WHISKEY BRAVO was away awkwardly then bumped soundly with STRONG HUMOR, raced at the rear while ridden along and failed to threaten. STRONG HUMOR was bumped hard at the start and forced into another rival then taken up off heels early, raced off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. FULL HEART came out and bumped soundly with STRONG HUMOR at the start, raced off the pace while ridden along, bumped with STOURBRIDGE LION while inside midway through the turn and faltered.
