CHINA was away alertly, set the pace under pressure, dueled inside on the turn, inched clear in upper stretch and held gamely under strong urging. ICON IKE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, showed no speed while ridden along, went three then four wide on the turn, swung seven wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to just miss. GLOBAL POWER was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE bumped with READY FOR MORE at the start, was hard ridden while off the pace, moved out leaving the backstretch, went three then two wide early on the turn, dropped to the inside by the five-sixteenths pole, angled out under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly. CASH REFUND was sent hard from the start, chased then pressed the pace, dueled outside on the turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. ZEB chased the pace, lugged out a bit while four wide on the turn, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. HOLLYWOOD HIT pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back passing the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. READY FOR MORE bumped with rivals at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, raced four then three wide on the turn, was in a tad tight near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. (Rail at 10 Feet)
