GAFF prompted the pace outside MYSTERY CLASSIC from early on, gained the edge a furlong out and then held on. SMALLTOWN SLEW settled along the inside while outrun, angled out turning for home, rallied gamely but was too late. VENOMOUS unhurried, rallied mid track and made a late gain. MONKEY HILL moved to the inside going to the turn, continued inside until the drive, was switched out inside the furlong grounds and closed late. MYSTERY CLASSIC hard pressed while holding the edge, faltered late. RODEO'S CASTLE devoid speed, lacked a rally. BIG TOP CAT close up from early on, loomed three wide for the drive and then flattened out. SHREWD DEPUTY crossed to the inside early and was outrun. STORM SURGE showed speed to mid turn and then stopped.
