SPLASH OF ROSES was taken up a bit at the start, settled well off the pace, came under some urging while two then three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied under left hand urging in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under continued left hand urging. HITCH YOUR WAGON moved out and tracked the leader, chased three wide on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, gained a short lead into the final furlong, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and missed. THIS SMOKE DID IT sped clear from the outside post, crossed over in front of the field, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, was asked in upper stretch, came under the whip outside the furlong marker, lost the lead passing that marker and weakened while able to save the show. BERRY VALID raced towards the front of the field, chased four wide on the turn and tired. IKNOWUTHINKIMSEXY broke a bit slow, moved up into the middle of the field, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. COWGIRL KNOCKOUT brushed with a rival at the start, settled on the far outside, was urged along while five wide on the turn and had nothing left. POOCHIEWOOCHIE brushed with a rival at the start, settled at the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond then faltered.
