Footnotes

GREAT MILLS tracked the leader from second, bobbled near the three-eighths pole, ranged up while three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, was set down in upper stretch and inched clear under strong urging. YANKEE GONE SOUTH sped clear after the start and set the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and weakened then just held the place. BIRDIE BEATS PAR was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, floated six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick and just missed the place. SANTO GATO settled off the pace, raced four wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail, came under urging, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. ROCKIN IN DIXIE broke a bit slow then lacked early speed, raced inside on the turn and improved position. CALLINGAHARDTEN broke about three lengths slow, raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. OCHO CABALLERO broke a bit slow, was urged along while off the pace, moved closer while inside on the turn but came up empty. JABULANI dropped back while ridden along, raced four wide into the turn then dropped to one off the rail, lugged inward in upper stretch and was no factor. D' BANDITO broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. MASON LANE was urged along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. (Rail at 20 Feet)
